- Max sheet size is 11 x 17 inches. Your folded entry cannot be larger than 4.25 x 5.5 inches.
- Books must be 8 pages.
- Stapling and sewing is permitted.
- Digitally-produced work will be accepted.

All books will be handled and touched by visitors. Books should be durable. Keep this in mind if considering something vulnerable such as a glued attachment. Do not add endpapers or book boards. We shouldn't have to assemble anything. Nothing should dangle off or extend beyond the face of the book. We will display the books in clear hanging bags. Visitors will be able to remove the books for reading.

This is an OPEN CALL. Submit early. Submit more than one. Not just for artists. Calling poets, writers, designers, and photographers.

Complete your registration and catalog entry online and then submit your *physical* books.

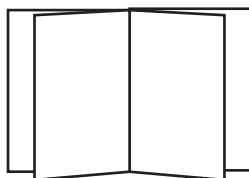
FEES

\$20 for 1-4 unique books. Each additional unique book is \$5. Submit as many as you like!

If your book has editions, we accept up to 3 additional copies at no charge (sold at same price). Editions do not count as another book.

The exhibition is not juried, but selected work will be featured. Early submissions may be included in our marketing efforts.

ONLINE CATALOG ENTRY

You are required to complete your catalog entries including title, description, photos, and price. Also a brief artist bio or statement. Once you register we will email instructions.

FINE PRINT

- Heavy Bubble may reject a book for any reason, refunding submission fee but not shipping costs.
- Artist is responsible for shipping. Submit books in a labeled, reusable protective package, such as a stiff 9 x 12 envelope.
- All books will be handled and touched by visitors and must not require assembly.
- If you want your book returned, provide postage or plan to pick up promptly.
- By entering you affirm that you possess copyright of the entire work and permit use of your work in promotion.

FOLD IN HALF LENGTHWISE



FOLD IN HALF

If this is a PDF, print on 11x17 paper and try it out! [PDF available: heavybubble.com/ritual]

1. fold in half lengthwise.
2. fold in half again.
3. fold in half again.
4. open.
5. fold to cut the center slit.
6. push the ends to the center.
7. fold one cut flap left and one right.
8. fold the top half away from you.

The tabloid-size format is intended to create a democratic show to encourage artists, poets, writers, designers, or photographers — not just those experienced in book arts.

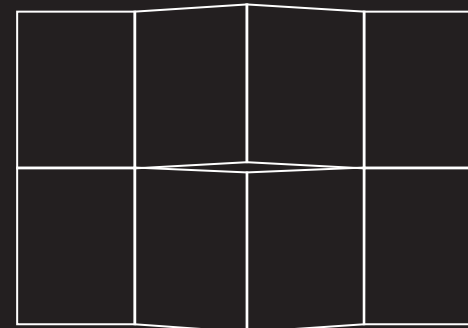
